Such respite will be provided in either a certified foster home environment or a group home setting for youth who require increased structure and supervision in order to be successful. The goals of Berkshire PINS/JD Respite program are to focus on the healthy preservation of the family, to help minimize any long-term disruption of families, to model appropriate family functioning, and help avert out-of-home placement.
